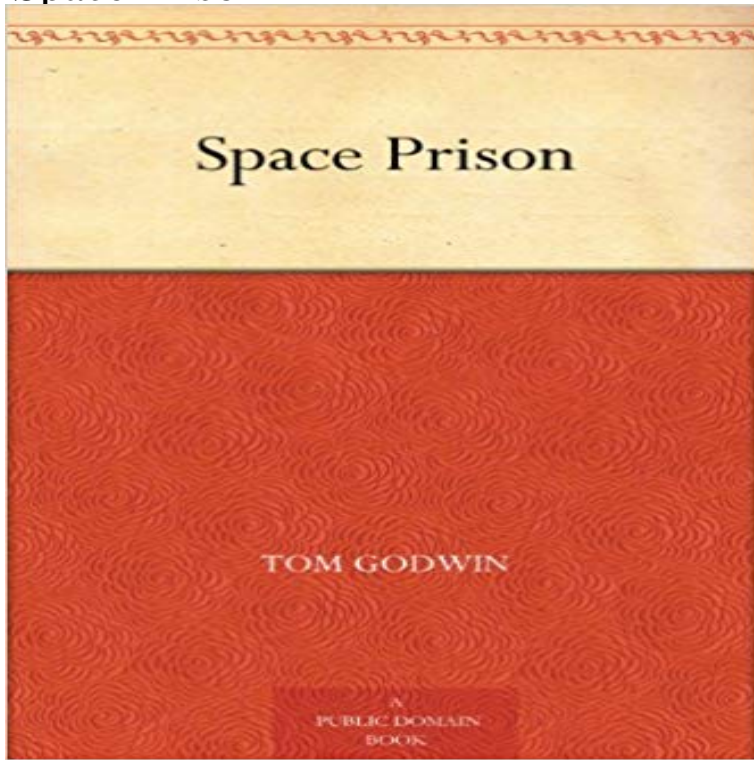


Space Prison
