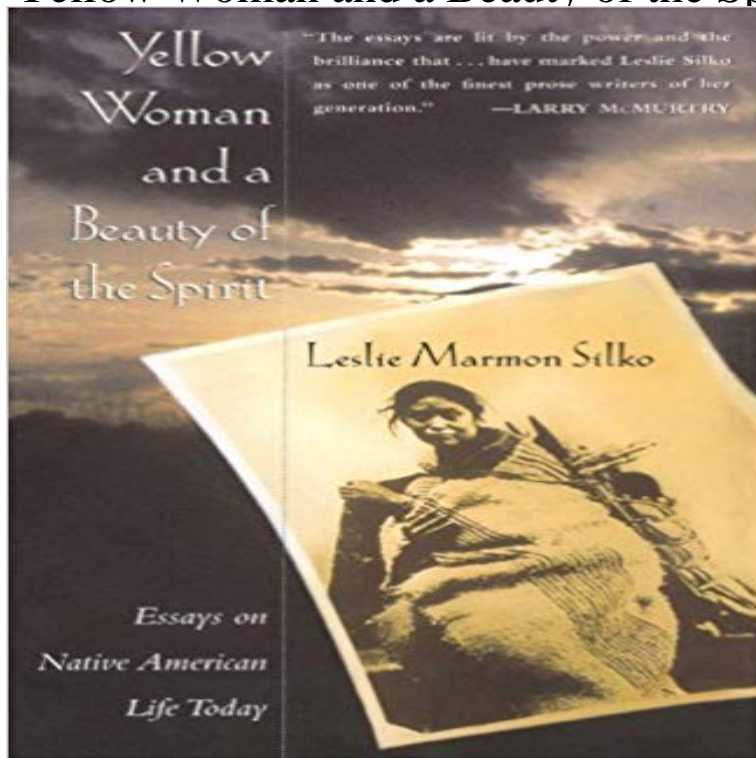


Yellow Woman and a Beauty of the Spirit
